How it all started



- The Lord Selkirk Regional Comprehensive Secondary School took four years to build.
- The credit system, semester system, and childcare program were firsts for this high school.
- The school plans began in 1967 with George B. Schreyer as the building chairman.
- The Lord Selkirk High School opened in 1971.
- 1150 students were enrolled and over 500 adults were in the continuing education program.

1971 Up Till Now

LSRCSS has gone through many changes with school policies and regulations, as well as renovations and updates.

Students used to be allowed to smoke in the cafeteria. No smoking is allowed on school property today.

The school also used to operate in a four-period system, when every class was around eighty minutes long. Now the students have a five-period day.

- **Cost \$500,000 to build the indoor pool.**
- **The pool is used by the LSSD students in grades 3, 5, 7 and 10, Selkirk Dolphins, senior citizens, scuba divers, preschoolers, and many more.**
- **3500 sq. feet, with 255 gallons of water, and can fit 170 people.**
