
## St. Andrews School

William Cockran was the founder of St. Andrew's School
Originally he and his wife taught school out of their home

# \*Old St. Andrew's School founded in 1827 \*Was located at 8 St. Andrew's Road \*A total of 5 buildings were used for this school



# New St. Andrew's School

- New St. Andrew's School constructed December of 1965
- The cost of the new school was \$4,416,000
- In the 1970's St. Andrew's School reached 520 students from grades K to 9
- St. Andrew's strives to give students a great school experience

**2001 - St. Andrew's Sewage Plant** 


2003 - St. Andrew's Portable
